Packing list arctic tours | Nature Tours of Yukon

Please be aware of following weather conditions:

The average temperature around this time of year in Yukon and NWT is between -2° and -24° Celsius. However, it is not exceptional that temperatures will drop as low as -45° Celsius. Therefore, we strongly recommend carrying appropriate winter clothing. If you do not have appropriate winter clothing, suitable (arctic) outer clothing may be rented from Nature Tours of Yukon.

We recommend for an Arctic / Ice road tour following clothing/equipment:

Clothing (min. 1 set of each):

- Thermal underwear: long johns and shirts with long sleeves;
- Wool socks, possibly wear thin socks underneath;
- Fleece trousers and sweater;
- Ski or Outdoor pants, with lining and insulation;
- Wool pullover;
- Long model down jacket with insulated hood and (faux) fur trimming;
- Thin wool gloves;
- Leather gloves or mitts;
- Wool or Fleece neck warmer or balaclava;
- Wool (musher's) hat or toque;
- Sunglasses;
- High winter boots, suitable to temperatures of -40°C or below;

For the evenings at the hotels:

- Regular, comfortable wardrobe. (Please note that people in the Yukon and NWT normally dress very casual!)
- House shoes or slippers.

Toiletries:

- Do not forget protective (lip) balm against cold winds!
- Please bring any medication, which you have to take regularly.

Miscellaneous:

- Spare subscription glasses
- Photo and/or Video equipment, please use lithium batteries!
- Tripod (for photographing the Northern Lights).
- Head lamp

Documents:

- Valid passport or photo ID
- Credit card(s) (preferably "MasterCard" or "VISA").
