Packing list Chilkoot Trail | Nature Tours of Yukon

When planning your equipment, please keep in mind that you will have to carry your own backpack. Besides your personal gear you have to carry your share of food and group equipment.

Nature Tours of Yukon provides the following equipment:

- Tents, food-snacks & beverages, water treatment, camp stove / fuel, kitchen equipment & eating utensils.
- First aid kit, satellite phone, bear spray (pepper spray).

Guests bring:

Camping:

- Comfortable backpack (80-90 liters),
- Waterproof pack bags
- Hiking pants (quick dry), shirts/blouses, jogging pants/long johns, underwear, fleece jacket or pullover, T-shirts, rain/wind pants, rain/wind jacket, socks, wool gloves or mittens, scarf/warm cap(wool).
Please don't choose cotton. Bring quick dry fabrics
- Hiking/trekking (waterproof) boots.
- Lightweight shoes/clogs for camp use and/or creek crossings.
- Gaiters.
- Hiking poles.
- Sleeping bag. (rated at -5°C),
- Sleeping pad. / Thermo-Rest;
- Pocket knife, thermos/water bottle, matches/lighter, hat/sun protection;

Toiletries / First Aid:

- Toothbrush & -paste, biodegradable soap, small towel;
- Hair brush, sun lotion, insect repellent, lip balm, Band-Aid
- Sun glasses.
- Prescription glasses (spare)
- Please bring your prescription drugs!!!

Our guides are certified in wilderness First Aid and carry a limited first aid kit.



Miscellaneous equipment:

- Photo equipment
- Diary/note pad/pen.
- Binoculars (lightweight).
- Head lamp (August/September).

Documents:

- **Passport** and/or valid visa for entering USA.
- Copies of important travel documents - keep separate from originals!
- Credit card ("MasterCard" and "VISA" ok, "American Express" not very useful).
(It is almost impossible to exchange foreign currencies (except US\$) in the Yukon)
- Photo- and Video equipment:

Please keep adequate insurance coverage on your equipment!

Make sure you're insured for -Search and Rescue-.

You have to carry your own pack, so keep the weight of your equipment to a minimum!
You will also have to carry part of the group food and camping equipment in addition to your own gear.

Plan at home what you will carry and what you will leave in Whitehorse. (We'll store your luggage in Whitehorse for free!)

Don't forget to look around you: Take in the breathtaking views, see the Gold Rush relics, have fun and enjoy this unique trip into Klondike Gold Rush history.
